To Whom it May Concern:

This letter is to confirm that the Czech Muay-Thai Association chaired by President Mr. Petr Ottich is the official member in the Czech Republic of the International Federation of Muaythai Amateur (IFMA). The IFMA recognises only one official entity per country.

Muaythai under IFMA has been fully recognized by the Olympic Council of Asia since 1999 and became a full member of the world sport community in 2006 with inclusion in SportAccord. Muaythai under IFMA is a full member of TAFISA -Sport For All, and the International World Games Association (IWGA), and was recently announced as one of the 30 sports on the official programme of the 2017 World Games.

IFMA is a partner of the Peace and Sport Organization for its Sport Is Your Gang initiative for which it was awarded the 2014 Spirit of Sport Award, and also with UN Women for the campaign to End Violence against Women.

IFMA has recently received official patronage from the Federation of International Sport Universities (FISU) for the 1st Muaythai University World Cup which is being from 16-24 March 2015.

IFMA's application for IOC recognition has been accepted by the IOC Sports Department and is under the process of review and waiting to be forwarded to the executive board.
